Loss: Arson Fire

INTRODUCTION

A private school in Padua, Ohio had a fire in their basement.

The fire was eventually ruled as arson. It destroyed most contents in the basement and left the main floor of the building, where the offices and classrooms are located, covered in heavy soot.
